The U.S. Melges 24 Class Association's (USMCA) National Championship has officially set an all-time, record-breaking participation level with 54 entries (as of September 10). Considered the darling of the high-performance yachting world, the Melges 24 continues to set the standard by which all strive to achieve. It transcends the many levels of sailing as it is fun, easy to sail and fast. The fact that the who's who of sailing can often be found at the helm of this formula vehicle is just a mere bonus.

The National Championship, title sponsored by car manufacturer Audi (audiusa.com), is the pinnacle of the International Melges 24's North American Ranking schedule. Competitors travel from near and far, as well as cross country boundaries to get their Melges 24 fix. Just as in proceeding years, 2007 will be a true international event with three competitors from Canada including Peter Hansen, Uri Saks and Marc Steyn; and one from the UK — none other than 2007 St. Petersburg NOOD Champion John Pollard. This will be a whirlwind tour of events for Pollard and his *Xcellent* crew. On Sunday, the last day of this event, they immediately head back to do the UK Nationals in an effort to defend his reigning title.

The remaining entries are from the United States representing all six USMCA districts, from sixteen states — California, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Michigan, Mississippi, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Rhode Island, South Carolina, Texas, Virginia and Washington. The field of talent is deep including 2006 Melges 24 National Champion Owner Scott Holmgren, 2003 National Champion Argyle Campbell, 2006 North American Champion Brian Porter, 2007 Newport Regatta Champion David Ford, Chuck Holzman, Jack Jennings, Mike Dow, John Podmajersky, Bill Carleton, Timothy O'Neill, Mike Krantz and Steven Kopf just to name a few.

The 2007 Audi Melges 24 U.S. National Championship kicks-off with a pre-nationals racing clinic featuring 2007 Melges 24 World Champion Dave Ullman with Ullman Sails (**ullmansails.com**) generously sponsored by Latis Yachting Solutions (**latisyachting.com**). Afterwards, a post-sailing debrief will follow. Racing will commence on Friday and conclude on Sunday with an awards ceremony and prize giving.

Regatta Chair, Paul Hulsey and his team of event organizers have been hard at work on this event for many months and promise an event to remember. A very special thanks to Paul, the Bayview Yacht Club and title sponsor Audi. 
